<p><u>English</u> The Tiger Who Came to Tea If you have this book at home, then you can read the book or you can watch and listen to it. I have also enclosed a paper copy. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=BXgW9UCgpc8</p> <p><u>Tuesday</u> Make a shopping list for Sophie's mummy for when she goes shopping again.</p> <p><u>Wednesday</u> Talk about when you have had someone special come for tea. Then draw a picture and write a sentence to illustrate this experience.</p> <p><u>Thursday</u> Create your own invitation inviting someone special around to your house. Remember to include all important information (date, time, address etc.)</p> <p><u>Friday</u> Reread 'The Tiger that came for tea'. Discuss what happens at the beginning, middle and end of the story. Draw 4 pictures to retell events and attempt to write a caption to explain what is going on.</p>	<p><u>Diary</u> <u>Monday</u> Complete your diary. What activities have you been doing yourself keep busy? How did these make you feel? Did you have fun? Why?</p>	<p><u>Spellings</u> Do your spellings on the sheet provided Read them in a list. <p><u>Maths</u> Money <u>Monday</u> Track the Coin Game Read the instructions for <i>Track the Coin</i> (enclosed) and then use the board to enable you to enjoy playing the game together.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- You will need coins: 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p and £1 – one of each. You also need counters, which can be Lego™ pieces, dried beans, wooden beads or even something edible like raisins!- Line the coins up in the middle of the track.- Take turns to play the <i>Track the Coin</i>.- Complete the 'recognising coins' worksheet. Draw a line to match the coins to their names. <p><u>Tuesday</u></p>	<p><u>Science - Rainfall Gauge</u> We have learnt all about the Seasons and Weather in Science.</p> <p>Watch this clip which explains how people measure and record the weather. https://www.bbc.com/bitesize/clips/zybq6sg</p> <p>I have included 'How to make a rain gauge' sheet. It shows the materials you will need to make it N.B. Make sure the bottles are cut completely by an adult or have the cut started in the bottle. When the gauge has been made, position it outside in an appropriate place to catch the rain.</p>	<p><u>History - Wednesday p.m.</u> Our topic has been about Transport and changes over time. We have learnt about George Stephenson and his engine, the Rocket. We looked at early cars and space travel.</p> <p>So for the first two weeks of our home learning, I would like the children to design and make their own model of any mode of transport.</p> <p>For the first week, they draw and discuss their plan, making a list of what they require. Attached is the planning sheet.</p>

- Colour the coins to make the right amount.
