<p><b><u>Maths</u></b> <b>Money</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Complete the money booklet which is included in your pack for Week 1.</li></ul> <p>Also you can use your Heinemann ‘Money and Fractions’ book which is in your pack.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Completing 1 or 2 pages will be enough.</li></ul>	<p><b><u>Science - Rainfall Gauge</u></b> We have learnt all about the Seasons and Weather in Science. Watch this clip which explains how people measure and record the weather. <a href="https://www.bbc.com/bitesize/clips/zybq6sg">https://www.bbc.com/bitesize/clips/zybq6sg</a> I have included ‘How to make a rain gauge’ sheet. It shows the materials you will need to make it N.B. Make sure the bottles are cut completely by an adult or have the cut started in the bottle. When the gauge has been made, position it outside in an appropriate place to catch the rain. After a week use ‘Recording Rainfall sheet’. check on your rainfall gauge and see how much rain has fallen during the week. Complete ‘Changing Seasons’ worksheet</p>	<p><b><u>History - Wednesday p.m.</u></b> Our topic has been about Transport and changes over time. We have learnt about George Stephenson and his engine, the Rocket. We looked at early cars and space travel.</p> <p>So for the first two weeks of our home learning, I would like the children to design and make their own model of any mode of transport.</p> <p>For the first week, they draw and discuss their plan, making a list of what they require. Attached is the planning sheet.</p>
